Three Scholarships Available

Requirements:

- Applicants must be in their final year of high school and have been accepted to or enrolled in an institute of higher education.
- Applicants must be registered to vote and must have voted in a local, state or federal election within the past calendar year (12 months).
- Applicants shall submit an essay (no more than two pages, double-spaced) focused on why he/she voted in honor of a veteran. The essay shall contain a brief description of the veteran(s) for whom the applicant voted. It may also focus on topics such as, but not limited to, the role of elections in our form of government, the importance of voting in our form of government, the role of the military/veteran in our system of government or the applicant's definition/interpretation of patriotism.
- Application deadline is **May 1, 2016**

The applications will be reviewed and recipients will be selected by a committee consisting of members of the Charleston Exchange Club and the Charleston County Board of Elections and Voter Registration.
