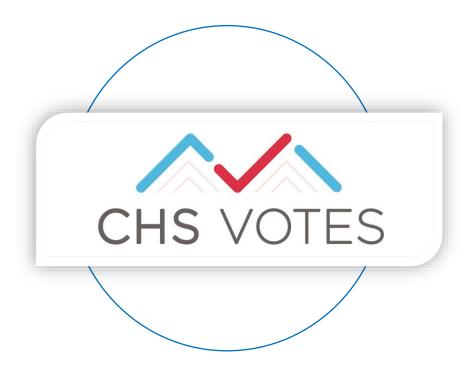

VOTER REGISTRATION DEADLINES

In-Person – October 1st



October 1st, 2021 is the last day to register to vote for the municipal elections.

Online - October 3rd



October 3rd, 2021 is the last day to register to vote for the municipal elections. Online registration can be completed at scvotes.gov OR completed registration forms can be emailed to voterregistration@charlestoncounty.org.

Postmarked - October 4th



Voter registration forms mailed to our office must be postmarked by October 4th, 2021 to be eligible for the municipal election.

ABSENTEE VOTING INFO

Absentee Voting Info

In order to be sent an absentee ballot by mail, you must return a signed application to our office. Then your absentee ballot will be mailed to you 30 days prior to the election.

Qualifications to Vote Absentee

- Working on Election Day
- Persons 65 and older
- Physical Disability
- Poll manager or watcher
- Vacation on Election Day
- Student
- Member of Uniformed Services on Active Duty
- Member of Merchant Marine
- Spouse or dependent of a member of the Uniformed Services or Merchant Marine
- US Citizen residing outside of the United States
- Government employee
- Jury duty on Election Day
- Admitted to hospital as emergency patient
- Family death or funeral within 3 days prior to the election
- Confined to jail or pre-trial facility

IN-PERSON ABSENTEE VOTING

In-person absentee voting starts Monday, October 4th at the Charleston County Board of Elections office located at: 4367 Headquarters Rd. North Charleston, SC 29405

Voting absentee in-person does not require an application prior to arrival.

Satellite Absentee Voting Schedule

Hours: 9:00 AM - 3:00 PM

October 18th: James Island Rec Center

October 20th: Mt. Pleasant Wando Library

October 22nd: Seabrook Island Town Hall

October 25th: Bees Ferry West Ashley Library

October 27th: Arthur W. Christopher City Gymnasium

October 29th: Isle of Palms City Hall

All eligible voters can vote absentee at any of the satellite locations or at the Board of Elections main office.

ABSENTEE VOTING BY MAIL

The Basics

- ✓ Sign your ballot's return envelope and have a witness sign
- ✓ Ballots can be mailed back to our office or can be dropped off in person at the main office or SVU
- ✓ Ballots cannot be picked up at our office
- ✓ Return your ballot as soon as possible after receiving it
- Damaged ballots can be replaced by contacting our office
- ✓ If you leave any race blank, every vote you did mark will be counted

POLL WORKERS NEEDED

You can apply online to become a poll worker at https://charlestonsc.easypollworker.com/home.

Poll workers are paid \$135 per election

Qualifications

- -Must be 16 and older
- -Must be a registered voter in South Carolina if older than 18.
- -Be willing and able to attend a Poll Worker Training Session and pass a written certification test.
- -Be prepared to work the entire Election Day, from 6:00AM until approximately 7:30PM.
- -Be non-partisan and neutral when working an election.

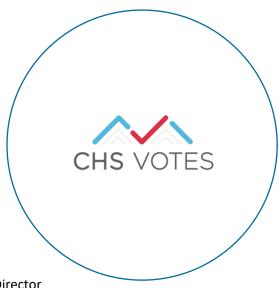
